Intelife will help you get an advocate if you need help to find one.

An advocate is someone you can trust and who is on your side. Sometimes this is a family member, friend or a support person you know well.

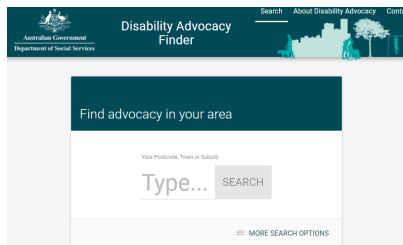
It's always a good idea to get an independent advocate when your legal or human rights are not being met and when you think you are being treated unfairly.

A professional advocate is paid to be an advocate for their job. They can help you to:

- tell people what you want and what you need
- tell people when something is wrong
- understand information and make decisions
- get the services you need
- know about your rights
- make a complaint
- get choice and control in your life

The government funds disability advocacy services. They are free for people with disability.
