Intelife was created in 1991 by a group of parents who wished to create opportunities for their children with disabilities. A team of seven people provided activities and work opportunities for 24 school leavers, and it soon became clear there was a wider need for similar programs and services.

This led to the creation of a broader employment service in 1993, followed by the development of Intelife's community access and engagement program in 1996.

Since its inception, Intelife has been committed to providing people with disabilities an inclusive environment in which they can build skills, engage in meaningful work and enjoy tailored activities.

Lifeskills

Our Lifeskills area supports individuals to maintain and develop new skills, build meaningful relationships, and engage in community activities that are in your NDIS plan and are important to you.

Examples of the types of support we may be able to offer you are:

- Getting out into the community
- Learning daily living skills and household tasks such as cooking
- Making friends
- Living a healthy life
- Exploring new hobbies and interests
- Going to appointments and shopping

Supported Employment

At Intelife, we work with you to understand your work goals and support you to achieve them.

Our Supported Employment program offers you a variety of options to:

- set employment goals
- engage in paid employment
- gain new skills
- access work experience opportunities
- receive ongoing training
- transition into open employment, with or without support, if you wish



We have a range of contracts with government agencies and private businesses to provide you with a range of work opportunities. We offer work in small crews in the areas of gardening, cleaning, litter and roadside collection, office work, car cleaning and more. We also encourage you to let us know if there are other jobs you'd like to try or new skills you'd like to develop.

These opportunities give you real-life work experience in social situations that support you to develop and achieve your employment goals.

Customised Employment and School Leaver Support

Customised Employment is a flexible, personalised approach that supports school leavers or mature aged job seekers to get ready for employment.

Customised Employment has four steps to employment. First, we work with you to discover what type of work you'd like to do, then we plan, make goals and find and test suitable opportunities.

Our team can support you to embark on a career in supported or open employment, start your own business, study, volunteer or do some work experience to find out more about what suits and interests you.

Support Coordination

There is a wide range of funding and resources available to people with disabilities.

Understanding exactly what's on offer and what's right for you can be overwhelming.

Intelife Support Coordinators work with you to understand your NDIS plan and funding availability. We work to make sure you get the best mix of supports so you can maintain relationships, live more independently and be included in your community.

We also offer support connection to build your ability to connect with informal, community and funded supports enabling you to get the most out of your plan and pursue your goals.
