Driven by an unshakeable passion, seven parents pioneered activities and work opportunities for 24 school leavers. Witnessing the immense impact, they swiftly recognised the wider need for similar programs and services.

In 1993, their vision broadened, giving rise to a comprehensive employment service. Three years later, in 1996, Intelife's community access and engagement program took shape. These milestones are not just dates; they are markers of our unwavering commitment to spark change and foster inclusivity.

An engaging commitment

Intelife is committed to providing people with disabilities an inclusive environment in which they can build skills, engage in meaningful work, and enjoy tailored activities.

We can support you to engage with your community, learn life skills, offer employment pathways, and provide real-life employment experiences to help you reach your goals.

Informed approach

Lifeskills

We support you to maintain and develop new skills, build meaningful relationships, and engage in community activities that are in your NDIS plan and are important to you.

Examples of the types of support we may be able to offer you are:

- Getting out into the community
- Learning daily living skills and household tasks such as cooking
- Making friends
- Living a healthy life
- Exploring new hobbies and interests
- Going to appointments and shopping.

Customised Employment



Customised Employment

Customised Employment is a flexible, personalised approach that supports school leavers or mature aged job seekers to get ready for employment.

Customised Employment has four steps.

Step 1: We work with you to discover what type of work you'd like to do.

Step 2: We plan, make goals and find and test suitable opportunities.

Step 3: We match your skills and strengths to a job that suits you.

Step 4: We support you at work to settle into your new job and provide the ongoing support that you need.

Our team can support you to embark on a career, study, volunteer or do some work experience to find out more about what suits and interests you.

Wherever you are at on your employment journey, Intelife can help you achieve your career goals.

At Intelife, we work with you to understand your work goals and support you to achieve them.

Our Supported Employment program offers you a variety of options to:

- Set employment goals
- Engage in paid employment
- Gain new skills
- Access work experience opportunities
- Receive ongoing training
- Transition into open employment, with or without support, if you wish.

We have a large number of government and private contracts that provide a range of work opportunities, including:

- Gardening
- Cleaning
- Litter and roadside collection
- BBQ cleaning
- Office work
- Car cleaning and more.
